The Digital Journey Begins Next Year

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to provide an update on our school's digital learning initiative for the upcoming academic year. As part of our commitment to preparing students for a technologically advanced world, we will begin our digital learning program from Grade 4 to Grade 9, with a slight adjustment to the device strategy.

On the next coming years, instead of hard copy textbook, students in these grades will be required to have their own personal tablet device for classroom use. This "Bring Your Own Device" (BYOD) model gives you greater control over your child's learning tools and provides them with a device they can use both at school and at home.

This is a change we are confident will benefit our learners immensely. To ensure a smooth transition, we have compiled a guide to assist you in purchasing a suitable tablet for your child.

Consider these factors when choosing a tablet for your child:

Operating system: The tablet's OS will dictate the apps available and how it interacts with other devices.

Android: A good, cost-effective option with wide application availability through the Google Play Store.

Durability: Invest in a high-quality case and screen protector. Given the daily use, durability is a significant factor in a tablet's longevity.

Performance: Opt for a tablet with a fast processor and at least 4-6 GB of RAM. For grades 4 to 9, a quad-core processor is a good baseline.

Screen size: For reading and longer tasks, a minimum 10 to 12 inch screen is recommended, though a 10 inch or larger screen is preferable.

Storage: 128GB of internal storage is recommended to hold necessary apps and files, but tablets with expandable storage (via microSD card) are also a good option.

Battery life: Ensure the device can last for a full school day (around 8-10 hours) on a single charge.

Recommended devices for grades 4-9

Lenovo Tab M10: These Android tablets offer strong performance for their price, good battery life, and can be paired with an Active Pen and keyboard for more complex work.
